

# Where Do Tutorial Questions Come From???

The following are guidelines to completing your tutorial request forms.

- I. To find something to use for tutorial requests, first ask yourself:
  - A. Was there anything discussed in my classes today or yesterday that confuses me?
  - B. Do I have any questions on my notes that weren't answered during class discussion?
  - C. Do I have any quizzes or tests coming up that I can review or study for?
  - D. Do I have any homework assignments or projects that I need help with?
  - E. Do I have all the necessary materials needed to assist me with any of the above?
  
- II. If none of the above seem to apply to you, then ask yourself the following:
  - A. Which classes do I not currently have an "A" in?
  - B. Is there something in the class that I can review or study more to improve my class work or grade?
  - C. Have I received an assignment, quiz, or test back that I could go over and review to understand my mistakes?
  - D. What projects, term papers, portfolios, etc. do I have that MAY NOT BE DUE in the near future, but I can get started on?

Example: Organizing, planning, writing, or researching

*With the above questions to ask myself, I should always be able to find something to write on my tutorial request form for class.*
